PUBLIC NOTICE Award of One Stop Operator

Mother Lode Job Training (MLJT) is a Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Title I-financially funded program and is an equal opportunity employer/program.

The purpose of MLJT is to increase the involvement of the business community, including small business, minority business enterprises, and labor organizations in employment and training activities under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA), and to increase employment opportunities for residents of the member counties.

Local Boards must select their AJCC Operator through a competitive process at least once every four years (WIOA Section 121[d][2][A]). As part of that competitive process, Local Boards are required to clearly articulate the expected role(s) and responsibilities of the AJCC Operator (Title 20 CFR Section 678.620[a]). AJCC Operators may be a single public, private, or non-profit entity or consortium of entities. However, if a consortium of entities consists of AJCC partners, it must include a minimum of three of the required AJCC partners listed in WIOA Section 121(b)(1). In California, AJCC Operators are responsible for coordinating service delivery among all AJCC partners and service providers within the Local Workforce Development Area (Local Area). By having the AJCC Operator act as the local service delivery coordinator, it allows Local Boards to focus on strategic planning and developing partnerships at the local and regional level.

A Request of Quotes was advertised and solicited on May 8, 2023 for the 2023-25 One Stop Operator and closed on June 7, 2023. The RFQ for the One Stop Operator was also posted to the agency's website. The RFQ was responded to only by one bidder.
